Mission Statement

The Poquoson Public Library serves its community by providing free access to resources and services that meet the educational, informational, and recreational needs and interests of its citizens in a variety of formats.

Vision Statement

The primary functions of the Poquoson Public Library are:

- Operate as a free public lending library with reading materials, in a variety of media, for the interest, information, and enlightenment of all people in the community.
- Provide access to emerging technology for the community, including facilities and opportunities for instruction.
- Encourage and facilitate early literacy skills in young children providing programming, resources, and services for preschoolers and school-age children that encourage them to expand curious minds and to develop an interest in reading and learning.
- Serve as the lifelong learning center for the community providing classes and events, outreach, and resources for the education and entertainment of all ages.

In support of these functions, the Poquoson Public Library has identified the following strategic priorities: Community Engagement, Staff Training and Development, Sustainability, Development of Services & Resources, and Support of the Library as a Lifelong Learning and Community Center.

Community Engagement – to ensure the library is reaching and engaging citizens and effectively articulating the library's value to Poquoson's quality of life.
